

Original Anglo-Zulu War oil paintings for sale.

Due to my proposed 'downsizing' I no longer have adequate space for all my collection of these superb and original works of art and regretfully six are now offered for sale to Society members. These remarkable Anglo-Zulu War oil paintings are by the well known military artist, Jason Askew, and signed by him. They are professionally framed and were originally commissioned by me for my personal collection. Since the 1990s these paintings have been regularly exhibited by the Society at its own exhibitions and at a number of military museums including Brecon, RA Woolwich and RLC Deepcut.

They have also been viewed by David Rattray and members of the Royal Zulu family who visited the collection at Tenterden.

Jason's painting commissions have been numerous and include Sir Brinsley Ford, the buyer for the Prince of Wales on behalf of the Royal Regiment of Wales; the Imperial Light Horse Museum, Johannesburg; the Rand Light Infantry Museum, Johannesburg; the Australian Embassy, Pretoria; The Order of St. Lazarus, Johannesburg; RHQ King's Border Regiment in Carlisle and The Queen's Lancashire Regiment in Preston. His paintings also grace the walls of several regimental collections, including the Brigade of Gurkhas, the Staffordshire Regiment, the Coldstream Guards and the French Foreign Legion museum in Corsica.

Other works have been commissioned by Peter Jackson, director of the Lord of the Rings trilogy. James Teacher of Teachers Whiskey commissioned '*Pte Mossop escaping Hlobane*'. '*Mkhosana – Hero of Isandlwana*' was commissioned by John Urquhart and '*Melville Saving the Colours*' was painted for John Thompson, President of Garlock Chemicals in America.

I am also disposing of two Mk II Martin-Henry rifles last used in India. It is not known how they reached India. As can be seen from the untouched photograph the woodwork reflects their age. The mechanisms are in working order. The Calibre is 577cm/0.45 inch. Price £550 each.
